1. **Draft 2006 annual report on social dialogue and collective bargaining**
Round-up of changes and amendments made to the document and final chance to discuss it before it is presented to the Executive Committee.
2. **Review of 2006 conference, discussion of draft agenda for 2007 and proposed session on “Future of industrial relations in the public services”**
Chance to comment on the proposed content, speakers, arrangement and timing of debates etc in the light of comments and criticisms of the 2006 conference. There will also be a more detailed debate about the proposed session on the future of industrial relations in the public services.
3. **Young workers and Migrant workers**
Final chance to consider proposed amendments to draft policy documents before they are submitted to the Executive Committee.
4. **A round-up of progress on other collective bargaining policies**
Policies on low pay and outsourcing are the most recent additions to the collective bargaining policies developed by EPSU over the years. This review will outline where we are on these issues and what still needs to be done.
5. **Social dialogue and collective bargaining information**
EPSU has been able to maintain and extend the information it provides via the internet and is currently working on a series of country profiles on collective bargaining in the public services. There will be a report on progress plus a chance for participants to comment on the structure and content of the profiles.
6. **ETUC Congress and collective bargaining resolution**
Discussion of the draft resolution and ETUC approach to collective bargaining
7. **Collective bargaining resolution for EPSU Congress**
First chance to debate the key elements of a draft resolution.
8. **Sustainable development**
This was one of the six areas identified in the collective bargaining resolution at the 2004 Congress and there will be a short note circulated highlighting the key points of a draft policy document on the subject.
9. **Pensions**
Update on portability directive and plans for seminar in June.
10. **Any other business**
