

Union plans action against private care company

Denmark

The FOA public services union has warned the Vikapleje private eldercare company that it will face strike action from 15 June unless it ensures that its employees are paid in line with the municipal agreement. The company provides services for the Halsnæs municipality north west of Copenhagen and FOA has been trying for some time to negotiate an agreement with the company along the lines of those it has with many other private companies. The union estimates that Vikapleje is costing workers as much as DKK 90000 (EUR 12000) a year in lower pay and pension benefits.
