Energy workers get 2.6% plus lump sum

Portugal

Employees of the REN and EDP energy companies are getting a 2.6% pay increase this year along with a €160 lump sum. The lump sum payment will go to those with at least six month's service an with no unjustified periods of absence. Workers at REN will also have to have achieved at least level 3 on the company's performance measurement scale. Inflation in Portugal fell to -0.4% in the year to March, according to the national statistics agency.
