Waste workers take action on pay and other conditions

Portugal

Members of the <u>STAL</u> trade union employed by two waste companies – the private FCC Environment and municipally-owned RdN – took strike action between Christmas and the new year. Workers in both companies are seeking a 10% pay rise with a minimum monthly increase of \leq 100 and minimum wage of \leq 850 a month. In addition, the main claim at RdN is for all workers on temporary contracts to be made permanent.
