(29 March 2018) EPSU and affiliates contributed to the book <u>Reclaiming public</u> <u>services</u>. How cities and citizens are turning back privatization. It includes several examples of unions that campaigned for a return of services to public ownership. We worked closely with campaigner and editor Satoko Kishimoto of Transnational Institute (TNI). She was recently interviewed by one of our Belgian affiliates.
