

Minimum Income campaign takes to the road



(16 May 2018) EAPN the European anti poverty network has launched a mobile campaign to support demands for an adequate, accessible minimum income. EMIN buses are on the road, and will travel to **32 Countries, for 64 days, over 120 events!**

EAPN will talk to people in big cities and small villages, collect support for adequate, accessible minimum income schemes, and bring support to people longing and fighting for a real social Europe.

The first stops on the programme were on 25 April, then the buses will continue their [journey across Europe](#) to collect signatures on the bus, and highlight the [online petition](#).

Minimum income schemes are an essential part of universal social protection systems and ETUC, EPSU and many others are supporting the campaign.
