Equal pay victory for women council workers

Hundreds of women working as cleaners and care assistants have won an equal pay case against Birmingham City Council, the biggest municipality in the country. The Emploment Tribunal agreed with the union's case that the women had been unfairly denied bonuses that were paid to gardeners, refuse collectors and gravediggers, who are overwhelmingly male workers. The local authority has the right to appeal against the decision.
