**Practical details**

**Participation**

The conference is open to all EPSU members but affiliates from Denmark, France, Ireland, Italy and Latvia are particularly encouraged to attend.

**Gender balance**

We would encourage affiliates to help us improve the gender balance at this event by nominating women delegates.

**Interpretation**

Interpretation has been requested to and from Danish, English, French, Italian and Latvian. We have also requested that participants may speak but not listen to German and Swedish.

**Venue and time**

The conference will take place in the Auditorium of the International Trade Union House, 5 Boulevard du Roi Albert II, 1210 Brussels, with registration from 8:30, and the conference starting at 9:00 and ending at 17:00 on Tuesday 1 October. A buffet will be served at lunchtime.

**Travel and accommodation**

European Commission funding means that we can provide reimbursement to some participants with the priority going to affiliates from Denmark, France, Ireland, Italy and Latvia.

A hotel list offering preferential tariffs to EPSU / ETUC is attached.

The funding enables EPSU to contribute to:

- The travel of participants with a maximum of 350 euros. You are therefore requested to use APEX or cheapest tickets. **In order to be reimbursed, tickets and boarding cards must be kept and sent back to EPSU after the conference with the expense claim (taxis will not be reimbursed).**
- The accommodation of participants up to a maximum of 148 euros per night for a maximum stay of 1 night. A second night may be covered if participants have difficulty in getting a return flight on 1 October.

**In countries for which we are able to reimburse more than one person, one of the two delegates should be a woman. This is in line with EPSU equal opportunity policies.**
