### Why WICARE?

- severe lack of information concerning wages and working conditions in the social services across EU and outside EU
- need for comparative information for collective bargaining strategies of unions at national and European levels

### WICARE aims ...

- to analyse wages, working conditions, occupational structures, skills and industrial relations in workplaces
- using a large-scale survey in print and a web survey

# The survey

- Survey is in the national language(s) in many countries
- Invitation to web visitor: please complete survey (prize incentive)
- For WICARE customized version of the survey

### Survey questions about ...

- Wages, bonuses, contribution & entitlement to social security
- Working hours, overtime, weekend/evening/night work
- Working conditions, work intensity
- Employment contract, employment history
- Occupation, education, region, religion
- Household composition, age, country of birth
- Well being and satisfaction with the job and pay

# WageIndicator websites



### All websites: 3 pillars

- Pay -> up-to-date information about wages (Salary Check) and minimum wages
- Law & advice -> up-to-date information about labour law, compliance form, Decent Work Check Career & training -> tips for interviews and for training
- All websites are in the main national language(s)
- All websites invite visitors for the web survey
- All websites answer visitor's emails

### Web strategy

- Cooperation with trade unions and media partners with high Internet penetration: portals, newspapers, career sites
- Web-marketing and search engine optimization attracts millions of web-visitors (2012: almost 20 million)

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# Survey customized for WICARE



### Web survey

- web survey customized for social services
- teasers to this web survey are posted on all national
   WageIndicator websites in the 30 countries
- web marketing to increase response to survey
- EPSU affiliates are asked to post links to the web survey on their websites

### Print survey

- print survey extracted from the customized web survey
- available in PDF and Word format
- EPSU affiliates are asked to print the survey in their magazines or to distribute it to workers at their workplaces or in meetings
- affiliates collect completed surveys and return these to EPSU

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# Reports resulting from survey - 1



### Nine topical reports

- 1. Employment contracts
- 2. Occupational structures and skills
- 3. Remuneration, overtime compensation
- 4. Participation in benefit and pension schemes
- 5. Workers' representation
- 6. Working hours, irregular hours
- 7. Working conditions, work-related stress
- 8. Satisfaction with pay and working hours
- 9. Socio-demographic characteristics
