Euro-demonstration in Budapest - Hungary
Saturday, April 9, 2011

Dear Colleagues,

At the ETUC Executive Committee meeting in Brussels on February 8, it has been decided to organise as part of the European Action Day a big European event in Budapest, in co-operation with the Hungarian trade unions (LIGA, ASZSZ, SZEF, ÉSZT, MSZOSZ, MOSZ).

This Euro-demonstration will coincide with the Hungarian EU Presidency and the forthcoming meeting of Ministers of Economy and Finance (ECOFIN) and the European Central Bank to be held on 8 and 9 April 2011 in Gödöllö (Budapest) to discuss the financial crisis.

<u>We protest in Budapest</u>: "For a Social Europe, for jobs and well-being, for equitable taxes and laws.

This mobilisation is a continuation of our campaign against austerity and cuts which are applied today in most countries while also recalling the alternative policies proposed by the ETUC for growth and more and better jobs.

The ETUC calls on its affiliates to mobilise around these dates to ensure maximum impact at the Euro-demo in Budapest.

Join us in Budapest: Further details will be announced soon but we pledge to support this European day of action by sending a powerful delegation and a strong message to the Finance ministers and to the Presidents of the central banks in Budapest on 9th April.
