National Demonstration

The CGIL has called for a huge national demonstration on Saturday 27 November in Rome for **“the future of our youth and work”** to demand “more rights and more democracy”, to return work to the centre of contract negotiation, to demand development, equity and social justice, to drive the nation out of the crisis.

With this demonstration, we want to denounce the critical conditions in which immigrants citizens are forced to live, to emphasise that negation of the rights of immigrants has negative impact on the rights of all those living in this nation.

CGIL demands:

- **a battle against the exploitation of black market work**, through actuation of European Directive 52, the application and extension of Article 18 of the Consolidation Act also to those who report being forced to work irregularly;
- **a structured route to emergence** which, further to assigning residence permits to those embezzled during the last amnesty and to those who were victims of the Manganelli circular, offers an opportunity to escape from slavery and exploitation to hundreds of thousands of migrants, forced into irregular residence;
- **an extension of the residence permit** for those who have lost their jobs and are struggling to find another, removing the threat of expulsion;
- **a reform of citizenship**, to emphasise the need for a genuine extension of citizenship, starting with those born in Italy, for a multi racial society;
- **the right to administrative voting**, to overcome discrimination, for a more democratic society;
- **reuniting families**, to interrupt the conditions of solitude and family precariousness, because this is a better investment in a future of legal immigration;
- **a genuine policy of asylum**, which respects the Constitution and the international commitments given.

CGIL considers that positive resolution of these question is the premise for a more democratic, more united, fairer, multi racial future for this, our nation.
