Dear inhabitants of Alcazar de San Juan,

As Deputy General Secretary of the European Federation of Public Service Unions (EPSU) I support your struggle against the privatization of the local water company. We have collected over 1.68 million signatures across Europe to declare water and sanitation a Human right and to prevent EU wide liberalization. When we see that in your city of about 30.000 people you have collected over 11.000 signatures to keep it in public hands, we know this is a major achievement. EPSU has been the backbone of the right2water ECI.

As Europe's public service trade unions (EPSU), we see many people in Europe fighting against the privatization of water companies such as in Portugal, Ireland, Greece, Germany and elsewhere. People know that water is a public good and so essential for life that it is better kept in public ownership.
