

NO MORE TO LOWEST PRICE WORKERS!

The European Commission, Parliament and Council are currently revising the EU public procurement Directives.

On 28 May workers from cleaning, catering, security and construction in FGTB and CSC and with the support of their European trade union federations will gather to make their demands for the revision heard.

The current Directives encourage public purchasers to take into account only price, and not the quality of employment conditions. This logic has concrete impact on workers and on public budgets: loss of jobs, reduced hours, unbearable work pace and flexibility, unpaid wages, massive fraud...

Workers expected that the current revision leads to a change in this situation. The public procurement Directives must give priority to respecting workers rights and put an end to lowest-price bidding, thereby making it possible to take into account the quality of work and other social criteria.

This is why on 28 May workers directly affected by the revision will present to the European Commission our demands for a 'workers Directive'. We hope that the Commission, together with the Parliament and Council, will take account of the impact that the European reform will have on our lives..
