We would like to invite you to this first webinar on third party-violence and harassment at work to review definitions, legal frameworks (national, EU and ILO), impact and role of social dialogue.

It will take place on **Tuesday 15 June 2021 from 14h00 to 16h30** – the zoom link will be sent later to all those who register.

The project researcher Jane Pillinger and Eurofound will guide us through the discussion.

The webinar is the first of a series of events as part of our joint project with **CEMR, HOSPEEM, CESI, ETUCE, EUPAE, ETF, UITP, and ETNO** on the role of social partners in preventing third party violence and harassment at work which will run until February 2023.

The project will examine and discuss the prevalence, causes and impact of third-party violence and harassment at work in the partners' respective sectors as well as recent legislative and social partners' responses to this major health and safety matter of common concern.

It will aim to assess the application at the national level of the 2010 Multi-sectoral Guidelines to tackle third-party violence and harassment related to work and whether further actions might be needed to make its implementation more effective.
