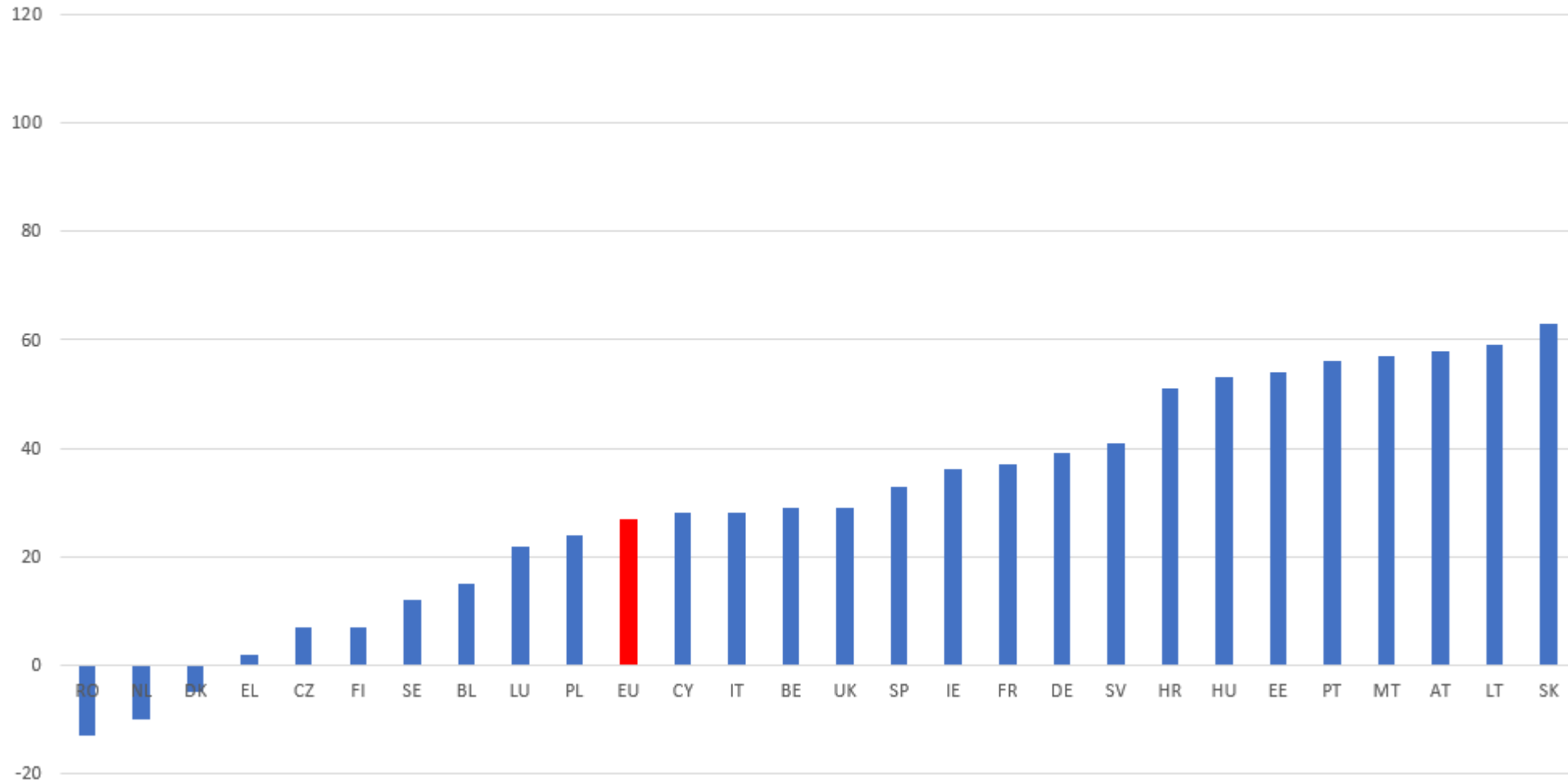

## Employment evolution 2008-2017 in the social services sector

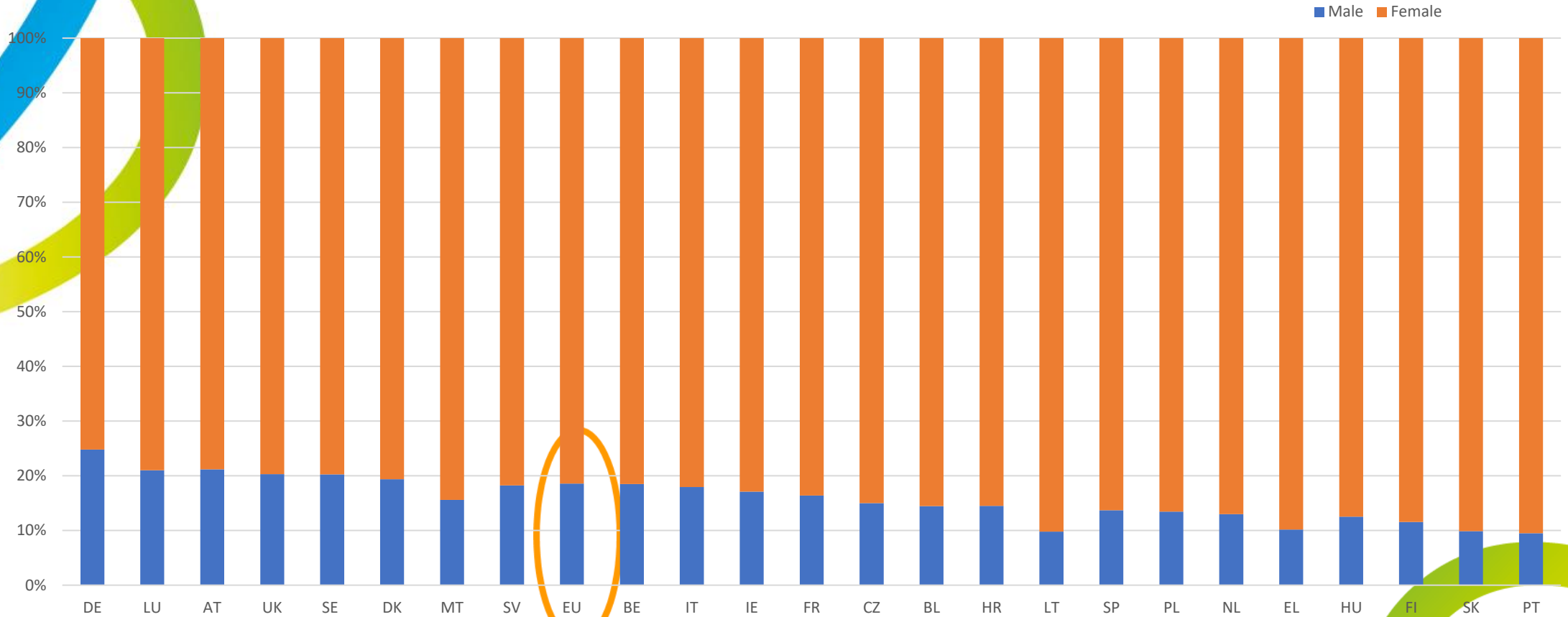


The social services sector has a strong employment dynamic with a 24% increase in the number of people employed between 2008 and 2017 (red column in graph).

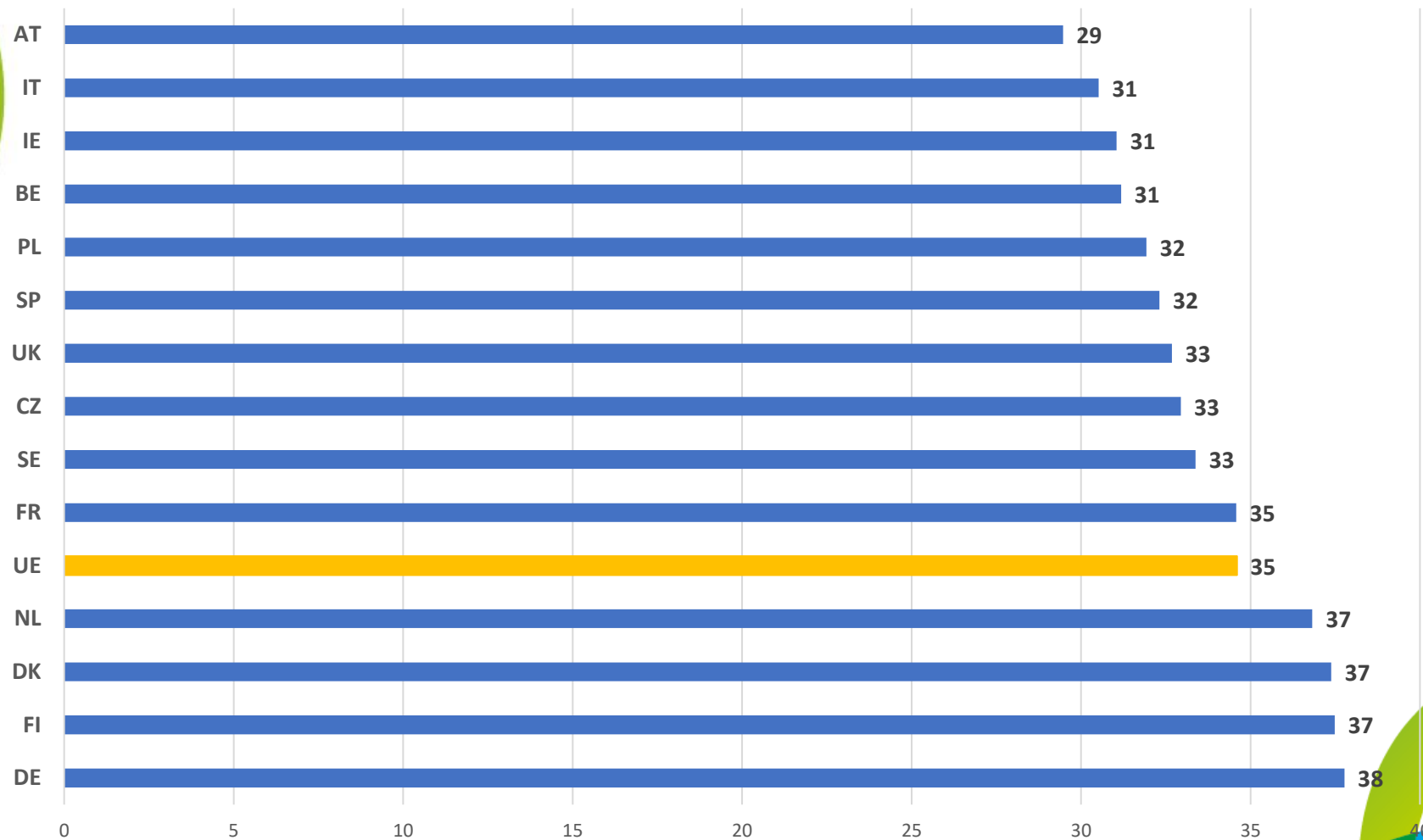
Over the same period, employment rates increased by only 1% at EU level for the whole economy.
