Workers informed on how employers monitor and use data

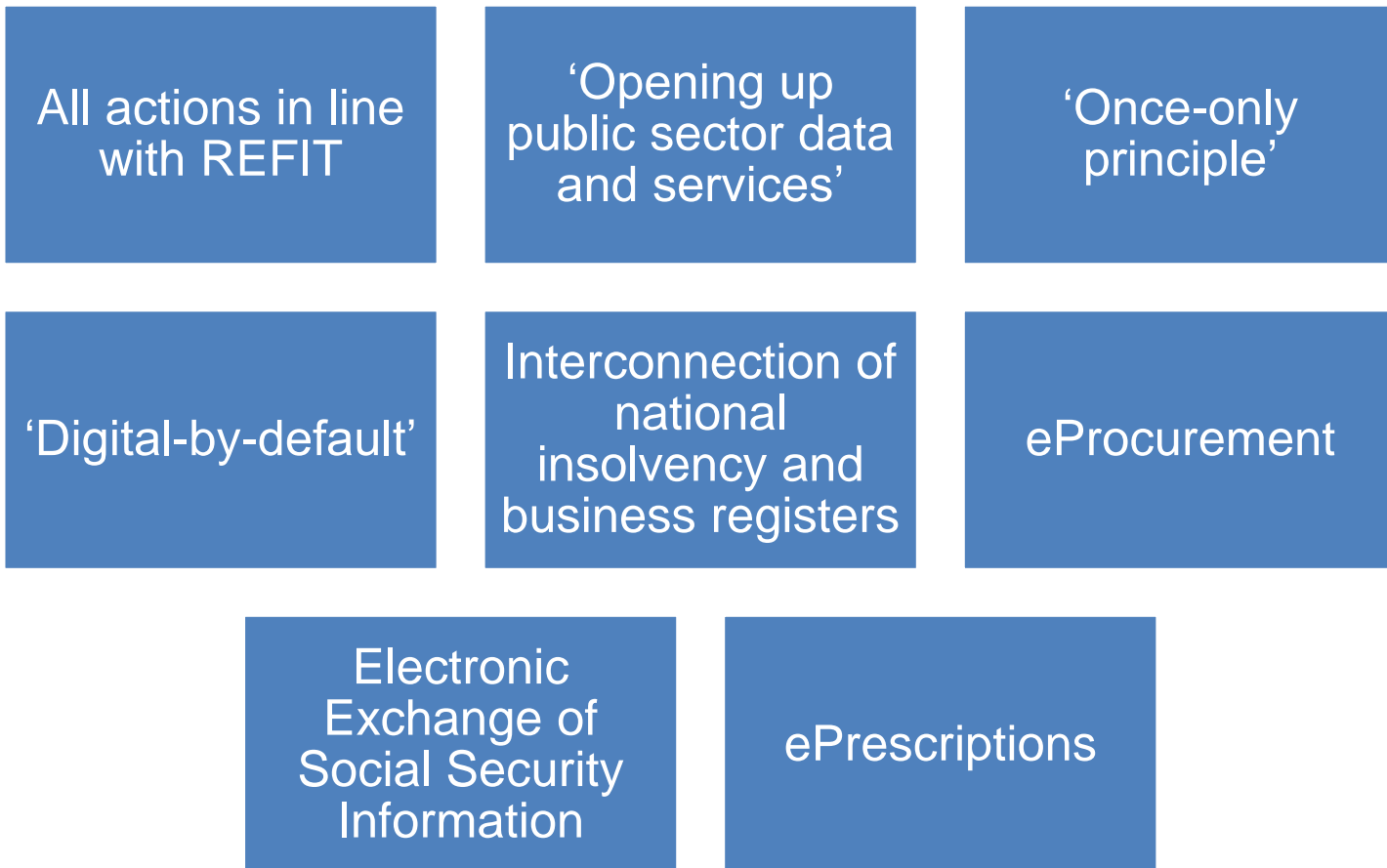
Worker data protection legislation at EU level
