




## Municipal waste treatment (2010)

#### Resource efficient society

#### □Waste:

- By 2020, waste is managed as a resource.
- Recycling and re-use of waste are economically attractive options.
- Landfill eliminated.





Substantial increase in employment along with growing turnover

□ Forecast:

50,000 new jobs in waste management
500,000 new jobs in recycling





- New functions: sorting, consulting, high-tech and engineering
- Sorting: a problem zone of fast-paced, lowwage, risky conveyor belt work
- Some secondary labour market in recycling
- Skill upgrading? (environmental consulting)





- Workload intensification
- Uneven and difficult representation and social partnership
- ➤ Limited time of contracts → losses of tenure with new contract
- Unequal working conditions for new entrants
   = fragmentation of workforce
